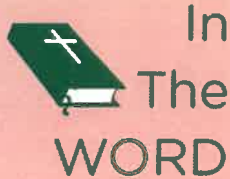

Family and Community Care Report for January-December 2018

*The money collected each week in the adult classes goes into the
Family and Community Care (Benevolent) Fund.*

1. Twelve people were assisted with sacks of food kept on hand at the church building. These sacks of food were obtained from the Sonshine House – your donations of food/toiletries help fill these sacks.
2. T & B partners with “First Step” of Wichita Falls – a shelter and counseling center for victims of domestic violence and sexual assault. Ten women were assisted: one with a bus ticket out of town; eight with a partial deposit on an apartment, and another with partial funds toward a car loan payment and car insurance.
3. Seven people were helped with gas in their vehicles; five people were given city bus tickets; one person was helped with purchasing a car battery; one person was helped with towing; one couple was helped with a motel room; one person was paid for yard work to purchase a lawn mower; one person was given a mattress, box springs and bed frame; three people were given help purchasing a bus ticket out of town.
4. Five members of the Tenth and Broad church family were helped with various needs.

In addition, Tenth and Broad sends a donation each month (from the Benevolent Fund) to the Westview Boys Home in Hollis, Oklahoma, Christian Homes and Family Services of Abilene, and High Plains Children’s Home in Amarillo.
