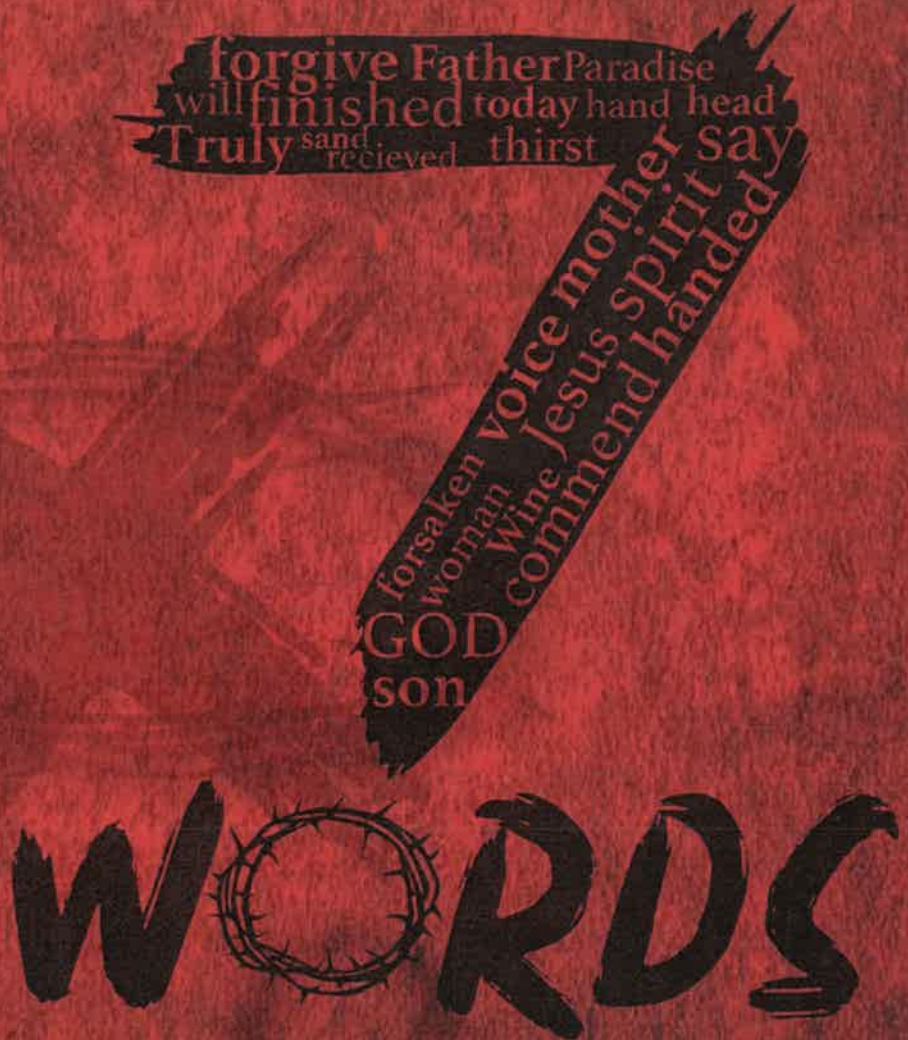

Word of Assurance

Luke 23:39-43

Sunday, March 10, 2019

*One of the criminals hanging beside Jesus hurled insults at him. 'So you're the Messiah, are you? Prove it by saving yourself - and us, too, while you're at it!' But the other criminal rebuked him, 'Don't you fear God even when you are dying? We deserve to die for our evil deeds, but this man has not done anything wrong!' Then he said, 'Jesus, remember me when you come into your Kingdom.' And Jesus replied, "I assure you, today you will be with me in paradise."*

WHAT MUST I KNOW TO BE SAVED?

**I Must Know That I Will Face \_\_\_\_\_ After I Die**

*Don't you fear God even when you are dying? Luke 23:40 NIV*

*Everyone must die once, and after that be judged by God. Hebrews 9:27 TEV*

**I Must Know That I Have \_\_\_\_\_ Against God**

*We deserve to die for our evil deeds... Luke 23:41 NIV*

*The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 6:23 NIV*

**The Word of Assurance**  
**Luke 23:39-43**

Ice-Breaker

When I ask, 'what is one thing you are absolutely sure of', what is the first thing that comes to your mind? Go!

Text

Jesus said, "I assure you, today you will be with me in paradise." Luke 23:43 Based on this word of assurance, I must know four things to be sure of our salvation.

**I must know that I will face God after I die**

The criminal said, "Don't you fear God even when you are dying?" Luke 23:40

1. To us, death is the end of what we know. To God it is the beginning of our eternal lives with him. What does death mean to you? How about eternity?

**I must know that I have sinned against God**

The criminal said, "We deserve to die for our evil deeds." Luke 23:41

2. When we think of "evil deeds," we often think of what we read in the headlines. But what are some of the little things we do each day that might qualify?

**I must know that Jesus was more than a man**

The criminal said, "...but this man has not done anything wrong!" Luke 23:41

3. What do you know about Jesus that makes you believe he is more than a man?

4. Who do you believe Jesus is?

**I must know that only Jesus can save me**

The criminal said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your Kingdom."

5. What emotions and thoughts and passions do you hear in the simple phrase, "Jesus, remember me"?

Application

Romans 6:23 says, "The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." Paul contrasts the cost of sin with the gift of God in Christ Jesus.

6. What is the difference between wages and a gift?

Ephesians 2:8-9 says, "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith - and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God - not by works, so that no one can boast."

7. In what ways are you tempted to think you have earned your salvation? In what ways are you very aware that your salvation is the gift of God's grace?

8. Why do you think many people are not sure of their salvation? What keeps you from being sure of your salvation?

9. If you were absolutely sure you would be with Jesus when you die, how would it change how you live today?
