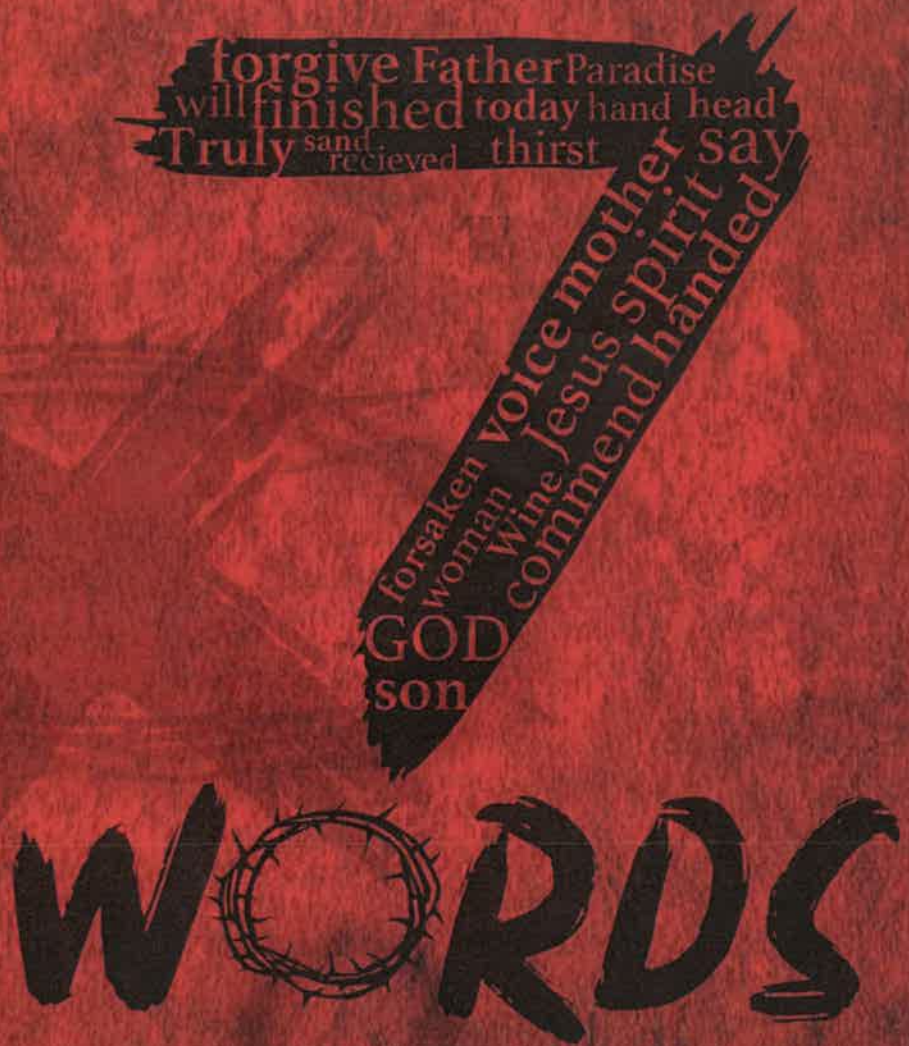

Matthew 27:45-56

At noon, darkness fell across the whole land until three o'clock. At about three o'clock, Jesus cried out in a loud voice, 'Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?' which means, 'My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?' Matthew 27:45-46 (NLT)

WHAT HAPPENED?

He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world. 1 John 2:2 NIV

Text and Application

1. Read Matthew 27:45-46

Take yourself back to the moment of Jesus' crucifixion and imagine being right there with Jesus on the cross. Describe how the scenery changes at noon, and discuss in your group how that makes you feel. What do you think is the significance of the darkness? How do you feel when you suddenly hear Jesus cry out to God three hours later?

2. Read 1 John 2:2

Atone means to pay for damages. Tell about something you have had to atone for. How does that help you understand that Jesus was your atoning sacrifice?

3. Read 2 Corinthians 5:21

Discuss with your group how this verse explains why Jesus knew that God had forsaken him. How do you know God has poured his goodness into you?

4. Read the following verses and discuss what happens when anyone comes in the presence of Holy God. Revelation 4:6b-11; Isaiah 6:1-5; Daniel 10:4-8

5. What are ways that you see how ugly sin is in the world around you? What are ways that you see how ugly sin is in you?

6. Read Romans 3:25 and Galatians 3:13

How would you try to explain to someone what salvation cost? How has this gift that cost Jesus his life but is given to you for free changed your life?

7. Read Romans 5:11 and spend time together giving thanks to God for this wonderful life we have because of what Jesus has done.
