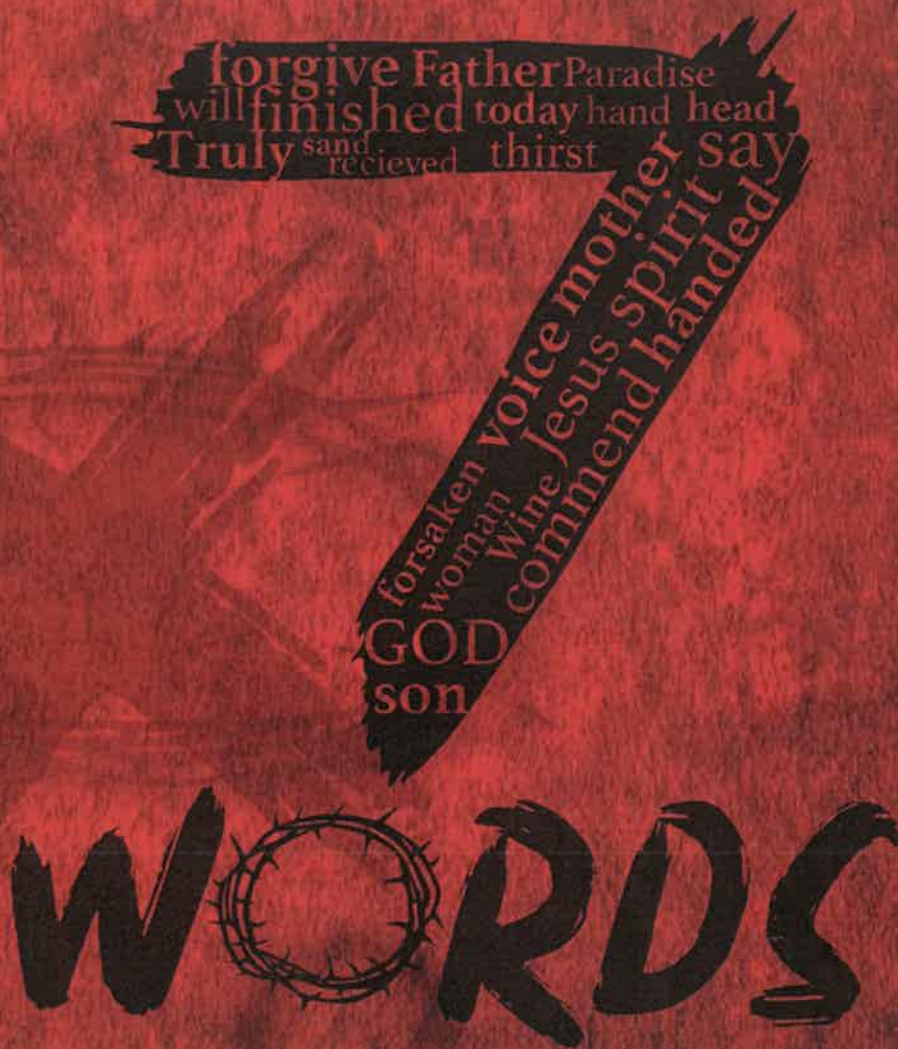

The Word of Victory
John 19:28-30

Knowing that all was now completed, and so that the Scripture would be fulfilled, Jesus said, 'I am thirsty'...after Jesus was given a drink he said "It is finished!" And with that, he bowed his head and gave up his spirit. John 19:28-30

WHAT DID JESUS FINISH ON THE CROSS?

1. He _____ what God had promised.

"When I was with you before, I told you that everything written about me in the law of Moses and the prophets and in the Psalms must be fulfilled." Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures. And he said, "Yes, it was written long ago that the Messiah would suffer and die and rise from the dead on the third day. It was also written that this message would be proclaimed in the authority of his name to all the nations, beginning in Jerusalem: 'There is forgiveness of sins for all who repent.' Luke 24:44-47 NLT

For all of God's promises have been fulfilled in Christ with a resounding "Yes!" And through Christ, our "Amen" (which means "Yes") ascends to God for his glory. 2 Corinthians 1:20 NLT

2. He _____ what God's justice required.

The law of Moses was unable to save us because of the weakness of our sinful nature. So God did what the law could not do. He sent his own Son in a body like the bodies we sinners have. And in that body God declared an end to sin's control over us by giving his Son as a sacrifice for our sins. He did this so that the just requirement of the law would be fully satisfied for us... Romans 8:3-4 NLT

After Jesus had finished his work, he became the source of eternal salvation for everyone who obeys him. Hebrews 5:9 GW

3. He _____ the debt that I owe God.

We owed a debt because we've broken God's laws. That debt listed all the rules we've failed to follow. But God forgave our debt, and he cancelled our debt by nailing it to the cross. Colossians 2:14 ICB

4. He _____ Satan's power to control me.

God has freed us from the power of darkness, and brought us into the Kingdom of his dear Son. Colossians 1:13 NCV

In this way God took away Satan's power to accuse you of sin, and God openly displayed to the whole world Christ's triumph at the cross where your sins were all taken away. Colossians 2:15 TLB

5. He _____ the fear of death.

For the sin of this one man, Adam, caused death to rule over many. But even greater is God's wonderful grace and his gift of righteousness, for all who receive it will live in triumph over sin and death through this one man, Jesus Christ. Romans 5:17 NLT

Because God's children are human beings—made of flesh and blood—the Son also became flesh and blood. For only as a human being could he die, and only by dying could he break the power of the devil, who had the power of death. Only in this way could he set free all who have lived their lives as slaves to the fear of dying. Hebrews 2:14-15 NLT

I tell you the truth, those who listen to my message and believe in God who sent me have eternal life. They will never be condemned for their sins, but they have already passed from death into life. John 5:24 NIV

In the past you were dead because you sinned and fought against God. You followed the ways of this world and obeyed the devil....But God was merciful! We were dead because of our sins, but God loved us so much that he made us alive with Christ...God raised us from death to life with Christ Jesus and he has given us a place beside Christ in heaven. Ephesians 2:1-6 CEV

By our baptism, then, we were buried with him and shared his death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glorious power of the Father, so also we might live a new life. Romans 6:4 TEV

You can be certain of this: God who began his good work within you, will continue his work in you until it is finally finished on that day when Christ Jesus comes back again! Philippians 1:6 NLT

The Word of Victory
John 19:28-30

Ice-breaker: Name an accomplishment or victory in your life that you are proud of.

When Jesus said 'It is finished' ...

He fulfilled what God had promised.

All of God's promises have been fulfilled in Him! That's why we say "Amen!" when we give glory to God through Christ. 2 Corinthians 1:20

Share a promise that God fulfilled in Christ that is meaningful to you.

He satisfied what God's justice required.

Christ ended the law so that everyone who believes in him may be right with God. Romans 10:4

Give some examples of how the law of sowing and reaping works in your life. In God's grace he satisfied the requirement of that law for you through Christ. How does that make you feel to know you are right with God?

He paid the debt that I owe God.

God's Son paid the price to free us, which means that our sins are forgiven. Colossians 1:14

Share a way that you are indebted to God. Are there ways that you are still trying to pay your own debt?

He destroyed Satan's power to control me.

God has freed us from the power of darkness, and brought us into the Kingdom of his dear Son. Colossians 1:13

Two ways Satan tries to control us is through temptation and condemnation. Which of those works best on you? Share some ways you have experienced victory over temptation and condemnation.

He defeated the fear of death.

Because God's children are human beings—made of flesh and blood—the Son also became flesh and blood. For only as a human being could he die, and only by dying could he break the power of the devil, who had the power of death. Only in this way could he set free all who have lived their lives as slaves to the fear of dying.

Hebrews 2:14-15 NLT

What are your fears about death and dying? Do you really believe you are moving from death to life? How does your baptism speak to this?

You can be certain of this: God who began his good work within you, will continue his work in you until it is finally finished on that day when Christ Jesus comes back again! Philippians 1:6 NLT
